A number of attacks on tourists in India have drawn world attention and criticism and raised questions over the safety of female tourists who travel by themselves in India. The most recent incidents show that both foreign and local women are prone to become victims of indecent assault. Some crime experts attribute the problem to several factors, such as the availability of illegal home brews, the prevalence of Internet porn, and the growing number of ill-educated single men who find no wife or migrate alone to big cities for work. Although a bill has been passed in India to impose harsher punishments on rapists, women still need to take precautions especially when not traveling in groups.

Here are some dos and don'ts for independent female travelers in India. If you have to go out after dark, use the women-only carriage on the metro or take a taxi to your destination. There should be a proper bolt on the inside of the door in case strangers may sneak into your room with keys. Avoid wearing revealing clothes, such as shorts or sleeveless dresses. Don't stare at Indian males, or they may think you are interested in interacting further with them. Don't accept drinks from strangers; the drinks may be drugged. Prepare a mobile phone to hand and set up a speed-dial number to call for help wherever you sense danger.

In the United States, some researchers have found chemicals that may kill insects harmful to crops have posed a threat to birds. Rachel Carson, who worked at the Fish and Wildlife Service as a famous environmentalist, published a book in 1962 to denounce the influence of pesticides on wildlife, but she could not provide strong relevant evidence at the time.

Three decades later, Theo Colborn confirmed Carson's criticism. Colborn was the winner of the Rachel Carson prize in 1999, a prize given every year by the National Academy of Norway to a woman who has defended the environmental cause. As a zoologist, Colborn participated in a research project assessing the health of the Great Lakes in North America, where a large quantity of chemicals had been poured. She observed that after the ban on DDT in the United States in 1972, the shells of seagull eggs had become more solid and the number of eggs had increased, but the eggs would not hatch. Colborn realized that chemicals mimicked hormones and disrupted the endocrine system of seagulls, which turned male seagulls into females, and, therefore, eggs would not hatch.

To cut the increasing electricity bills, here are some energy- saving tips. First, turn off the light when there's no one in the room. Use small cooking appliances in your kitchen as they consume less energy than larger ones. Shorten the duration of cooking by using a microwave instead of a big oven. In summer, use fans instead of air conditioners whenever possible. Remember to clean the air conditioner filter on a frequent basis; otherwise, a dirty filter will block the air flow of your air conditioner and increase energy use. Place your computer in 'sleep' mode when it is not in use for a while. Electrical appliances, such as televisions or DVD players, should not be left onstand-by, which does no good but consumes power unnecessarily. Replace your broken electrical facilities, such as washing machines, refrigerators, and air conditioners, with their counterparts which carry energy efficiency labels.
